Goethe und Schiller Monument Schiller Park

The impressive bronze Goethe und Schiller Monument overlooks the City of Syracuse from its black marble pedestal at the northern end of Syracuse's Schiller Park. Dedicated on October 15, 1911, the monument was presented by the German citizens of Syracuse in honor of Johann von Goethe and Friedrich von Schiller, two prominent and much-admired 18th Century German writers.

The bronze statue was cast in Germany and is mounted on a granite base. The figure of Schiller stands 11 feet high; the figure of Goethe stands at 10 feet 10 inches. It is one of only four in the United States. The others are located in San Francisco, Cleveland and Milwaukee.
