This month I would like to write a little about the 200th year of one of the best known and loved Christmas carols, *Stille Nacht*. This carol was sung for the first time on Christmas Eve in 1818 by Joseph Mohr, Assistant Priest and Franz Xaver Gruber, a school teacher and parish organist. Herr Gruber set the poem composed by Joseph Mohr to music on that very Christmas Eve.

As the organ at the church in Oberndorf, which is just a few miles from Salzburg, was not working, the two men stood by the crib of the baby Jesus after mass and sang the beautiful *Stille Nacht* with only guitar accompaniment. Little did they know that this sweet lullaby about peace and hope would become one of the most sung and popular Christmas carols of all times, capturing the hearts of millions of people through the ages.


